- 1. Aristocracy: Privileged ruling class.
- 2. <u>Democracy</u>: Government by the people exercised either directly or through elected representatives.
- 3. Oligarchy: A political system governed by a few people.
- 4. Monarchy: a type of government in which a ruling family headed by a king or queen holds political power.
- 5. Republic: A government having a chief of state who is not a monarch president.
- <u>6.</u> <u>Philosophy:</u> The search for knowledge and truth, especially about the nature of man and his behaviors and beliefs.
- 7. City-State: a state that has its own government and consists of a city and the area around it.
- 8. Polytheism: the worship of or belief in more than one god.
- 9. Monotheism: the worship of or belief that there is only one God.
- 10.Conquer: to overcome; defeat.
- **11.Tolerance:** a fair, objective, and permissive attitude toward opinions and practice that differ from one's own.
